HOTEL ARRIVAL

The two-story porte cochère shelters the arrival to the Four Seasons Hotel and Residences Fort Lauderdale and is serviced by a coordinated team of door personnel, valets, and Four Seasons concierge.

FOUR SEASONS HOTEL & PRIVATE RESIDENCES

Tara Bernerd, one of the most acclaimed designers in London, oversaw every aspect of the forty-two turnkey Hotel Residences and the forty-four decorator-ready private homes.

OCEANFRONT POOL DECK

The tiered terrace design of the third-floor terrace offers cabanas with infinity views of the sand and surf accompanied by the intuitive Four Seasons service.

SIGNATURE RESTAURANT BY MARTIN BRUDNIZKI

An all-day indoor-outdoor brasserie with an adjacent pool bar is located on the third-floor terrace. On the beachfront promenade, a star chef helms a fine-dining restaurant with a terraced veranda.

FAMILY POOL | INFINITY POOL

The centerpiece of the Martin Brudnizki designed third-floor promenade is the pair of distinctive horizon-edged pools, including one reserved for family activities. They are framed by cabanas and tropical landscaping by Fernando Wong.

FOUR SEASONS SPA

The Tara Bernerd designed retreat features private treatment and relaxation rooms and offers an array of procedures that use ingredients inspired by the oceanfront setting.

LANDSCAPE BY FERNANDO WONG

The sequence of composed tropical experiences begins at the arrival, framing the porte cochère and signature restaurant. Upstairs, the landscaped third-floor pool promenade is exclusively reserved for Four Seasons owners and guests.



THE FOUR SEASONS HOTEL

Noted architect Kobi Karp oversaw the contextual design of Four Seasons Hotel and Residences Fort Lauderdale. The building's elegant curved silhouette with oversized terraces is placed above a three-story podium and is designed to optimize the ocean and beach views from each residence. A louvered façade surrounds the base, enhancing the tropical plantings and terraced garden promenades.






A FOUR SEASONS ARRIVAL

The two-story porte cochère, tropically landscaped by Fernando Wong, shelters the arrival to Four Seasons Hotel and Residences Fort Lauderdale. To ensure privacy, there are distinctive entrances for the Hotel and the Private Residences. A coordinated team of door personnel, valets, and Four Seasons concierge greets owners and their guests.








OCEANFRONT POOL DECK

The heart of Four Seasons Fort Lauderdale is the Ocean Terrace, created by celebrated interior designer Martin Brudnizki in collaboration with creative landscape designer Fernando Wong. Two distinctive horizon-edged pools are situated on the captivating Côte d'Azur-inspired third-floor Ocean Terrace. This environment includes the ocean-view indoor-outdoor cafe and adjacent pool bar. Custom-designed cabanas provide sheltered comfort with uninterrupted views of the sand and surf. The carefully placed landscaping vignettes offer a tropical sanctuary above the sands of Fort Lauderdale Beach.



DISTINGUISHED DINING

Four Seasons Fort Lauderdale hosts the beach's two most desired epicurean experiences, designed by Martin Brudnizki. The thirdfloor pool deck houses an all-day indoor-outdoor restaurant with an adjacent pool bar. A fine-dining restaurant with a terraced veranda is located next to the garden promenade. Residents will be able to access priority reservations as well as arrange for in-residence dining through the Four Seasons concierge.



FOUR SEASONS SPA




FOUR SEASONS RETREAT




TARA BERNERD & PARTNERS

MARTIN BRUDNIZKI DESIGN STUDIO

The culinary experience at Four Seasons Hotel and Private Residences Fort Lauderdale will come to life with restaurants, lounges, and pool areas imagined by Martin Brudnizki Design Studio.
