









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The Vision: A Thought Made Real


Space to Breathe





Reception

Curated regularly, the exhibition will be ever changing to include everything from the finest collection of orchids, to rare items in the botanic field such as Bonsais and Petit Cactus. A gallery showcasing selected imagery capturing the best blossoming years for the orchids and garden planting beds per season will give further life and family comfort to the lobby areas.





RPBW's work has been recognized the world over, including major awards from the American Institute of Architects (AIA) and the Royal Institute of British Architects (RIBA).






