THE STORY OF COCONUT GROVE

The history of Coconut Grove dates back to 1825, when lightkeepers and their assistants from the Cape Florida Lighthouse began to visit the area. As the 19th century passed, settlers put down roots, leading to the opening of the wood-framed Bay View Inn in 1882. Early on, it was known as "Cocoanut Grove," a spelling that was eventually corrected. Visitors to the Bay View Inn included notable writers, artists, thinkers, and naturalists. The region's reputation as a hub for the bohemian grew.

Over the years, Coconut Grove became home to one of the United States' first naval air stations on Dinner Key and also rose to prominence as a farming community. Throughout the 20th century, the wood-frame buildings overlooking South Bayshore Drive were replaced by high-rise condominium buildings, and quaint small businesses were replaced by larger shopping malls. Yet Coconut Grove maintained a vibrant individual identity throughout these many changes.

The former Pan Am Seaport terminal is today home to Miami's City Hall, which sits on Dinner Key. The Barnacle State Historic Park and Vizcaya Museum & Gardens are just two examples of nearby attractions that boast the region's great history. World-class dining is represented by all sorts of cuisine, from the authentic Italian at Strada to the funky organic, local fare at Lulu in the Grove. The shopping offers a mixture of high-end and familiar destinations, restaurants, and a multiplex movie theater.

Coconut Grove remains one of the most affluent communities in Miami, but it has retained its spirit as a special place that revels in both the eclectic and the sophisticated. It is known as Miami's own retreat from the rigors of city life, and its laidback atmosphere and artistic bent make it an ideal destination for luxury living. With the advent of Grove at Grand Bay, the door is open for a new chapter in the story of Coconut Grove.

BRINGING THE GROVE TO LIFE

Bjarke Ingels and BIG set out to create an iconic development that would be as special as the Grand Bay Hotel that once stood on this spot. They aimed to integrate the natural beauty of Coconut Grove, while also celebrating and enhancing the individual lifestyles of its no-doubt-varied occupants. To this end, one of BIG's primary approaches was to create expansive outdoor living areas, which lend a seamless flow between the indoor and outdoor environments – a hallmark of Miami living.

"Because the bay is on a diagonal,"
Bjarke explains, "the two buildings actually turn and, rather than being front and back, they become side by side. ... The two buildings interact [with] each other as well as the surroundings. So you maximize the qualities, the enjoyment of the weather, and the enjoyment of the view." Grove at Grand Bay could be said to have a life of its own, one that will inspire its residents and the surrounding community to reach and achieve new heights.


CRAFTING A LIVING MONUMENT

It is said that, in 1873, Dr. Horace Porter sought to open a U.S. Post Office in the region and, upon seeing two coconut palm trees, declared that the site should be called Coconut Grove. Thus, the natural landscape of the area is an essential part of understanding what makes Coconut Grove so special. Terra and Bjarke Ingels entrusted the landscape architecture of Grove at Grand Bay to Raymond Jungles, Inc., a celebrated Florida firm with over three decades of expertise and accolades.


RJI extended that vision for the building itself into the landscape design. By starting with simple, clean, and detailed hardscape elements, RJI brought to life a landscape featuring 469 trees and 15,625 plants, which embrace the character of Coconut Grove and incorporate it into the very DNA of Grove at Grand Bay. Just as the buildings are intended to be an extension of Coconut Bay itself, so is the landscaping meant to interact with the tropical magic of South Florida.
